Course Name: Leadership in Invasion Games

Course Description: This course offers a variety of competitive and recreational activities to that are considered invasion games; this could include but is not limited to Capture the Flag, Basketball, Team Handball, Ultimate Games, and Rugby. The students will focus on invasion games that allow a variety of movements into another team's territory in an attempt to "steal" objects and return to their own territory without being captured or score points in their opponent's end. Invading players must decide on strategies that will enhance their ability to do this. To prevent teams from capturing their objects or score points, decisions about guarding are important. Chasing, fleeing, and dodging are skills utilized in these games. Offensive and defensive strategies will be highlighted in all game situations. Students will learn about how to work as a team to achieve goals and focus on leadership within these activities. Emphasis is on improving their skills, learning the rules of the game (physical literacy), and strategizing all while working on interpersonal relationships in a cooperative environment. In addition to the gameplay activities, students will also be asked to develop skills in refereeing and teaching one or more of the activities. Students will be assessed primarily on their leadership within the class displayed while refereeing activities and coaching their peers and younger students on how to play the games.

Final Course Project or Presentation: Teaching an activities to their peers or younger students. Students will hand in a lesson plan and teach the activity to their chosen group.

Evaluation / Assessment Structure: 1. Skills and Knowledge in learning activities. Can they demonstrate an understanding of the sport while playing?

- 2. Do they understand the rules and strategies to referee at least one of the activities (basketball) during in class games with minimal reminders of calls.
- 3. Teach a game to their peers.
- 4. Teach a game to younger students and help lead younger students through their acquiring of basic invasion skills.
